After some discussion at the last business meeting, it was decided that starting with the August edition of the Gale Winds, the newsletter publishing date would change from the date of the business meetings to the first(ish) of every month.

## VACANT –MINISTER OF ARTS & SCIENCES

Effective immediately, the position of Minister of Arts & Sciences (MOAS) is vacant. Nicole has decided to step down, and awaits her successor. All interested candidates should present themselves to the populace at the August business meeting (Monday 22 August 2011). Any candidates will then be sent out to the shire for consideration (via the September Gale Winds, email list, etc) and will be voted upon at the September business meeting (Monday 26 September 2011).

### Below is a description of the MOAS position:

The purpose of the Arts and Sciences in the Society is to help us recreate medieval life and culture. It is the responsibility of the Minister of Arts and Sciences to encourage everyone who wants to learn, teach, study, demonstrate, display, or practice some medieval art or science to do so.

MOASs have four principal tools at their disposal to help them with their work: Facilitation, Communication, Encouragement and Recognition.

**Facilitation:** Otherwise called “networking,” facilitation puts the people who want to learn stuff in contact with the people who know stuff.

**Communication:** Reporting is very important, but there is more to communication than reports. A good MOAS encourages communication among artisans. Find out what arts and sciences people in your group want to learn about. Arrange classes or workshops on those topics. If no one in your local group can teach, arrange for guest teachers from another group. Your Regional and Kingdom MOAS can help you find teachers if you don't know who to contact.

**Encouragement:** Encourage people in your group who are working on group and individual projects, help new members make or obtain basic garb and other necessities, and help members prepare to enter A & S displays and contests.

**Recognition:** Be aware of what people in your group are doing, praise their endeavors and make sure recognition is given where it is due! Public praise is a great motivator: have "show and tell" local meetings, arrange arts and sciences displays at local events or put a column in your local newsletter that features what artisans in your area are doing. Nominate worthy people for Baronial and/or Kingdom awards. Refer to Chapter 9, Awards, for more details.

The Arts and Sciences happen every day; when food is prepared to share, a new costume is made; armor is updated, in every attempt to look and feel medieval. Think about what you and your friends are doing every day to make the SCA come alive, and you will find the Arts and Sciences. The MOAS should foster growth of the Arts and Sciences in the SCA, keeping in mind that everyone will move at his/her own pace.

In the SCA framework, reporting is important and necessary, you should make every attempt to be complete and on time. Take time to communicate with your group to learn about their projects, progress, and any problems they may be encountering to include with your reports.

An effective MOAS willingly shares ideas and information. Learning is enhanced by researching, doing and teaching. Direct people to good SCA sources to find and share information such as local newsletters, Artes Draconis (the Arts and Sciences Newsletter of the Middle Kingdom), Tournaments Illuminated, or The Compleat Anachronist; or at a Royal University of the Midrealm (RUM) session, Pennsic, or local workshops.

# PROPOSED CHARTER CHANGES—PLEASE REVIEW

At the July business meeting, Carol Girard proposed some changes be made to the charter, to better ensure that our voting procedures for new officers are handled a little more efficiently as well as increasing the methods of allowed communication of officership vacancies, upcoming votes, etc. Please read the proposed changes below. We will be voting on these proposed changes at the August business meeting, unless there is considerable discussion and change to the proposal.

## First Change—Publishing of information:

Any place in the charter that references publishing something in The Gale Winds will be changed to read “publish.....in The Gale Winds or other appropriate means of electronic communication...”

## Second Change—Section 2-3—Filling Offices :

This section reads today as follows:

### Filling Offices

When a Shire office becomes vacant, the Shire shall recommend to the Crown a successor as follows:

Note: Upon normal completion of a term, the position must be opened and voted upon.

- A. If the retiring officer wishes to recommend a deputy who is willing and qualified to fill the office, the Shire shall support that recommendation as provided in II.3.D below.
- B. If the retiring officer has no recommendation, the Seneschal shall have published in the Gale Winds a Notice of Vacancy, a job description, and a request for written applications for at least one month, or one issue, whichever is greater.
- C. All applications shall be interviewed by the Seneschal, the retiring officer, and members of the Shire.
  - A. An appropriate officer appointed by the Seneschal shall attend if the retiring officer is not available.
  - B. Applications for Seneschal shall be interviewed by ALL officers and those Shire members who wish to participate.
- D. All applicants are then voted upon by the Shire, before being put before the Crown. If necessary, the Seneschal may appoint, a pro-tem officer to carry out the vital services of an office until a permanent successor can be chosen.
- E. Any individual remains free at any time to recommend to the Crown his own choice for officers, apart from any Shire recommendation, but such a suggestion shall not in any way represent the Shire as a whole.

## Proposed Changes:

### Filling Offices

When a Shire office becomes vacant, the Shire shall recommend to the Crown a successor as follows:

Note: Upon normal completion of a term, the position must be opened and voted upon.

- A. If the retiring officer wishes to recommend a deputy who is willing and qualified to fill the office, the Shire shall support that recommendation as provided in II.3.D below.
- B. If the retiring officer has no recommendation, the Seneschal shall have published in the Gale Winds or other appropriate means of electronic communication, a Notice of Vacancy, a job description, and a request for written applications for approximately one month.
- C. Applications for officers shall be reviewed by ALL officers and those Shire members who wish to participate during the next business meeting.
  - A. In the event that no applicants step forward for a Greater Officer Position, a pro-tem officer will be assigned by the Seneschal and the Notice of Vacancy will continue to run on the mailing list until an applicant is found.
- D. A notice of upcoming vote will be published in the Gale Winds or other appropriate means of electronic communication, listing all applicants (regardless of number of applicants). This will allow for proxy voting at the next Business Meeting (See VOTING).
- E. All applicants are then voted upon by the Shire, before being put before the Crown .
- F. Any individual remains free at any time to recommend to the Crown his own choice for officers, apart from any Shire recommendation, but such a suggestion shall not in any way represent the Shire as a whole.

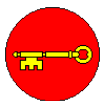
