CORDIAL MAKING PARTY

There will be a cordial making party / BBQ / Poker Night at Michelle & Chris's house this Saturday (30 July 2011) at 3pm.

For cordial making, we only need about 2 hours, unless someone makes a LOT of different flavors. All we need is space, and a table that we can make a mess on (we will be working with sticky stuff).

People interested should start accumulating the following:

- Clean glass vessels with airtight lids (I like to use mayonnaise jars with plastic lids). wide mouth is best if you are working with fruit. (you can use plastic, but this may impart unwanted flavors)
- Base alcohol (any unflavored liquors will do, but we typically start with vodka, rum, whiskey, or brandy). note that you can start with cheap rotgut if you are willing to wait 6 months or more for best drinkability (I like to do this with spice cordials). For something more immediate, you need to use the good stuff.
- Your favorite fruits, nuts, and spices (note that whole spices are usually easier to deal with than ground)
- Some kind of sweetener (honey, sugar, etc).

Becky will take everyone through the basics during the party. If you have something particular you want to try, and need help, contact her prior to the party and she will help you to figure it out.

Following the cordial making, there will be a BBQ (bring a dish to pass) and a shire poker night!
